Packing List



- Suitable outdoor clothing (appropriate to the weather and time of year)
- Suitable shoes for walking
- Change of shoes
- Indoor footwear (clean shoes or slippers)
- Changes of underwear and socks
- Nightwear
- Soap/Shampoo
- Face cloth/ towel
- Toothbrush/ Toothpaste
- Hair brush/ Comb
- Tissues
- Plastic bag for dirty shoes and clothes
- Torch
- Small teddy and/or book for room
- Travel sickness tablets (these should be labelled with child's name and clear instructions and given to the class teacher)

A packed lunch and drink will be required for the day of travel to Castleton

Please no fizzy drinks or glass bottles

Maximum of £5 spending money may be given for the small shop in the hostel but MUST be in a named envelope or purse and this will be the children's responsibility

Children may take a camera but they are responsible for its use and care (we recommend a disposable camera)

No mobile phones/ music players or handheld game consoles

It would be ideal to involve your child with the packing of his/hers suitcase using the above list as a checklist. This will help them to pack for the return journey.
