When is SATS week?

Tuesday 9th May	SPAG and Spelling
Wednesday 10th May	Reading paper
Thursday 11th May	Arithmetic paper & Reasoning paper 2
Friday 12th May	Reasoning paper 3

Children need to arrive at school **on time**. This will ensure we begin each assessment when scheduled.

Please ensure your child **attends school each day** during SATS as the assessment **cannot** be taken at a different time.

What can the children expect?

The assessments will take place in the Y6 classrooms, where they are familiar with their surroundings. Each class will be split into 2 groups (**a** and **b**) and will take the assessments at different times during the morning. The Y6 teachers will make your child aware of which group they are in closer to the assessments.

The papers will be marked externally and results will be given during the final parents evening for Y6.

Your child will have several practise assessment weeks to familiarise them with the routine.

How can you help at home?

Prior to SATS week, your child needs to be revising and revisiting learning and completing all homework. Your child will be supported with materials in school, however we advise that you support your child with revision as much as possible at home.

During SATS week it is important that your child gets **plenty of sleep** and has a **good breakfast** before coming into school.
